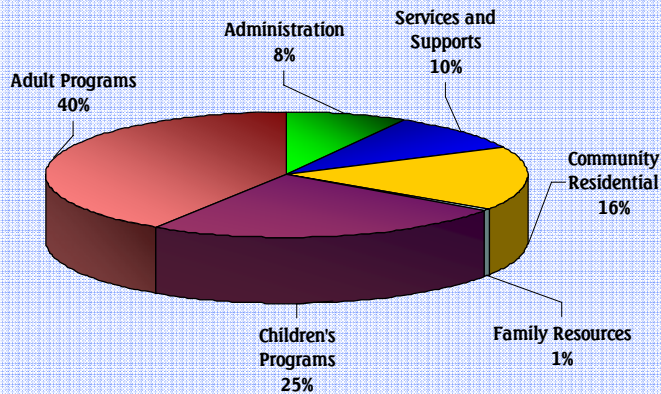

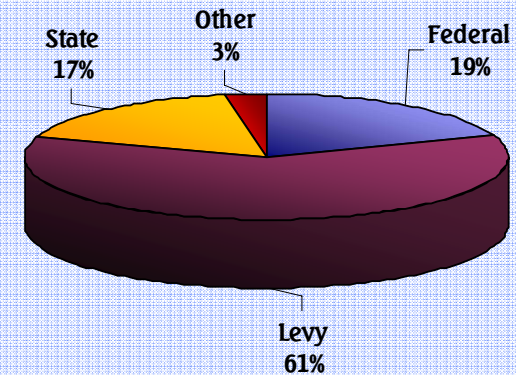
MISSION STATEMENT
